



March quarter turned out better for Qld than for southern states...


State Final Demand, quarterly growth, ABS chain volume estimates, Mar-09 to Mar-19





...but National Accounts confirm Qld economy highly dependent on Qld Gov't spending for growth


Decomposition of quarterly % change in SFD, ABS seas. adj. estimates, Mar-19

Qld Gov't capital purchases, 2019-20 estimates



Qld Government capital purchases as % of Gross State Product, 2001-02 to 2022-23





Excluding households doing renovations, private sector hasn't been too excited


Private capital investment, Qld, ABS chain volume estimates





Infrastructure pipeline not gushing...although Adani mine not included in these ABS estimates yet


Engineering construction work yet to be done, ABS estimates





Residential building approvals have plunged


Value of building approvals, monthly ABS Trend estimates, Apr-09 to Apr-19

12-month rolling sums of Qld exports by destination (top 5)



Over recent months, exports have fallen from end of 2018 levels





Services exports strong, too, as Queensland benefits from international education boom


Education, business & other travel exports, ABS estimates, 1999 to 2018





Qld employment growth has been below that of southern states recently


Employment growth, through-the-year, May-09 to May-19





Qld's unemployment rate stuck around 6%


Unemployment rates, ABS estimates, May-09 to May-19





Average earnings growth remains low


Average weekly adult ordinary time earnings, ABS estimates



Qld & Australian economic growth projected to be modest


GDP/GSP growth: Federal & Qld Treasury forecasts for 2018-19 to 2020-21
