



#### QLD currently has the highest gross debt in Australia


Projected \$90B by 30 June 2023, but NSW will have \$104B by that time




### QLD above NSW & VIC, but below SA & WA, in per capita terms








### General Government debt per capita higher than in NSW, lower than in VIC, SA & WA






## Gross debt per capita for GOCs in QLD lower than in WA, higher than in other states






#### QLD GOCs' interest expenses highest in Australia








## QLD's General Government debt to revenue broadly similar to NSW, lower than in VIC, SA & WA






### Total public sector debt to revenue ratio higher in QLD than in all states except SA






## QLD General Government net debt relatively low due to fully funded super liability (\$33B in investments)
